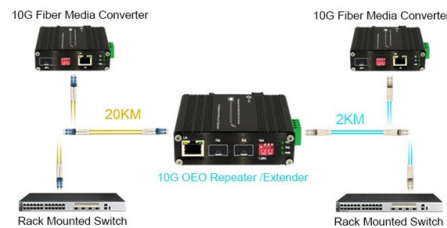


200m fiber optic cable using a 360 router

A standard 360 WiFi router can handle fiber internet, but for a 200-meter distance, you'll need either a high-quality outdoor access point or a point-to-point bridge to maintain stable connectivity.

360 WiFi Router Overview

The 360 WiFi system from Quantum Fiber is a Wi-Fi 7-powered mesh solution designed for whole-home coverage up to approximately 4,000 sq. ft. It supports multi-gig speeds, connects up to 100 devices, and includes built-in cybersecurity features. The system uses Wi-Fi pods connected to the SmartNID via Ethernet, providing seamless coverage without manual network switching. While excellent for large homes, its indoor range is limited compared to outdoor long-distance requirements.

Challenges with 200-Meter Fiber Runs

Standard indoor routers, including 360 WiFi, are not designed to maintain stable Wi-Fi over 200 meters, especially through walls, foliage, or other obstructions. Real-world testing shows indoor mesh systems rarely exceed 80-100 meters outdoors, and performance drops sharply beyond that. Therefore, simply connecting a 360 WiFi pod at the end of a 200-meter fiber cable may not provide reliable coverage.

Recommended Solutions

Outdoor Access Point (AP) or CPE

Use a weatherproof outdoor AP with high-gain antennas (≥ 12 dBi omnidirectional or ≥ 18 dBi directional) and PoE support. Operates primarily on 2.4 GHz for range and penetration; dual-band (2.4/5.8 GHz) can be used if higher throughput is needed. Provides consistent connectivity over 200 meters in open air or light foliage.

Point-to-Point Wi-Fi Bridge

Two matched units form a dedicated wireless link, acting like an invisible Ethernet cable. Reliable up to 500 meters with clear line-of-sight, minimal latency, and full bandwidth. Ideal for connecting two buildings or distant network segments without running Ethernet.

Fiber Cable with Switch or PoE Injector

For distances over 60 meters, standard Ethernet may require PoE++ (802.3at) or midspan injectors to power outdoor APs. Ensure the fiber optic cable is t...
