

# Bolt torque values for communication towers

**Antenna and Equipment Mounting:** Antenna clamps, RRU mounts, and microwave dishes use M12-M16 Grade 8.8 bolts, often with vibration-dampening washers (e.g., Nord-Lock) and anti-corrosion coatings like 316 stainless steel or heavy HDG for coastal environments.

**Recommended Torque Practices**

**Calibration:** Always use a calibrated torque wrench and verify calibration before use.

**Torque Verification:** Torque testing should be performed after tower erection to ensure nuts and bolts meet the specified preload.

**Break-Away Bolts:** For specialized clamping bolts (e.g., M16 aluminum alloy or M12 stainless steel), torque is applied to the upper head until it breaks away within  $\pm 10\%$  of the supplier's design torque, and records of installation torque and failure torque should be maintained.

**Inspection:** Annual inspection of all accessible structural bolts is recommended to check for looseness,...
