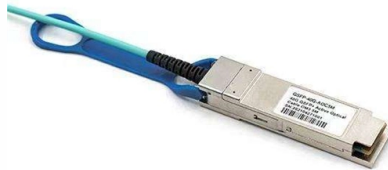

Medium and heavy-duty trays often include cable-friendly return flanges and are designed to support moderate to heavy cable loads without excessive deflection. This standard covers tray design, load capacity, corrosion protection, and installation practices. Channel support systems used with trays follow BS 6946. Compliance ensures safe support of electrical and communication cables, though trays are not intended as walkways or for supporting personnel. Installation Considerations Trays are designed for internal and external use, with pre-punched holes for quick mounting and integration with support systems. Proper installation requires assessment of Safe Working Load (SWL), span, and environmental conditions.
