Distribution box wiring requires high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matched to load current, proper insulation, and standardized installation for safety and compliance.

Wire Type and Material For building distribution boxes, copper core wires are recommended due to their excellent conductivity and durability. High-temperature resistant insulation is essential to prevent overheating and ensure long-term safety. Aluminum wires are generally avoided in small-scale residential distribution boxes because of lower conductivity and higher susceptibility to oxidation.

Wire Size (Cross-Sectional Area) The cross-sectional area of the wire must be selected based on the load current of each circuit. For example:

- Main input supply:** Typically uses a larger wire, such as 10–16 mm² for single-phase residential setups, depending on the main breaker rating.
- Individual circuits:** Lighting circuits may use 1.5–2.5 mm², while power outlets and heavy appliances may require 4–6 mm² or higher.

Always ensure the wire size matches the MCB or breaker rating to prevent overheating and tripping.

Insulation and Safety Use PVC or XLPE insulated wires rated for high temperatures. Ensure no exposed copper at terminals and proper color coding for phase, neutral, and earth wires. All wires should be neatly routed, secured, and labeled for easy identification.

Grounding and Protective Wiring The metal enclosure, electrical board, and appliance casings must be properly grounded. The protective neutral (PE) wire should be reliably connected through the terminal board. Include RCCBs, MCBs, or fuses for each circuit to protect against overload, short circuits, and leakage currents.

Wiring Practices Turn off the main power before wiring. Use standardized wiring methods to avoid loose connections or copper exposure. Ensure cable inlets and cover joints are sealed to prevent dust or moisture...
