

Cable Tray Fabrication and Cable Termination

Fabrication of Cable Tray Support Structures

- Corrosion protection:** Galvanization or stainless steel finishes are applied to resist environmental corrosion.

Cable Tray Installation

Cable trays are installed on the fabricated supports and can be perforated, ventilated, or solid-bottom trays depending on heat dissipation and cable protection requirements. Key considerations include:

- Spacing and bend radius:** Maintain proper spacing (6–9 inches for rungs) and minimum bend radius to prevent cable damage.
- Cable grouping:** Segregate power, control, and instrumentation cables to reduce electromagnetic interference and facilitate maintenance.
- Covers and protection:** Solid or ventilated covers may be used to protect cables from dust, mechanical damage, or environmental exposure.

High-Voltage Cable Termination

HV cable terminations (typically 10–35 kV) require specialized techniques and certified personnel.

- Termination kits:** Use manufacturer-approved kits (e.g., 3M or Raychem) suitable for the application.
