All materials, including trays, ladders, covers, and connectors, must be submitted for consultant approval before installation.
- 2. Site Preparation**Before installation, the site must be inspected for safety and accessibility. This includes: Checking the workspace for hazards or obstructions. Ensuring the layout fits approved shop drawings. Installing safety barriers and warning signs. Coordinating with other trades to prevent interference.
- 3. Storage and Handling**Materials should be stored horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at intervals of about one meter. They must be protected from moisture, direct sunlight, and construction activities. Damaged or unsuitable materials should be removed immediately.
- 4. Installation Process**The installation follows these steps:
 - Review Approved Shop Drawings:** Confirm tray routes, lengths, and mounting heights.
 - Marking and Layout:** Identify feeder names and branch numbers for each tray section.
 - Support Installation:** Install brackets, hangers, or supports according to load-bearing requirements, maintaining proper spacing between power and weak-current trays (≥ 150 mm) and firestop clearances.
 - Tray Assembly:** Connect trays, ladders, and covers using approved connectors. Ensure alignment and levelness.
