- Safety and accessibility:** Maintain at least 1 meter of clearance around the box for inspection and maintenance, and install boxes at 1.2–1.5 meters height for ergonomic access.
- Voltage levels and segregation:** Separate cables for different voltage systems to prevent interference and ensure compliance with safety standards.

The standard emphasizes minimizing cable failures, proper bending radii, and safe handling, which indirectly influence the practical choice of cable length.
