AI Overview

Crossbar (Rung) Overview

In ladder-type cable trays, crossbars or rungs are the transverse members connecting the two longitudinal side rails. They provide mechanical support for cables, maintain structural integrity, and allow airflow to prevent overheating of power and data cables. Standards Compliance: Cable tray crossbars and trays must comply with NEMA VE 1, NEC Article 392, and ASTM standards such as A123, A653, and A1008 for steel quality and coating.
