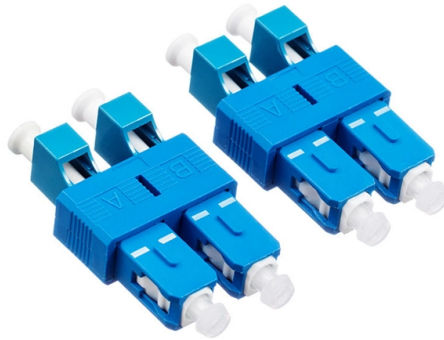

Dimensions

- Width and height are matched to the tray size (e.g., 100 mm to 600 mm wide trays)
- Thickness typically ranges from 1.5 mm to 3 mm for standard industrial trays
- Bend radius and spacing are designed to comply with minimum cable bend radius requirements

Load and Strength

Designed to support the weight of cables without deformation. Load capacity depends on tray type, span, and material. Ladder trays often use guide plates to maintain spacing for heavy power cables.

Standards and Compliance

- CE marking for European compliance, UL or NEMA for North American standards
- Tested for mechanical strength, electrical insulation, and fire resistance

Models and Types

- Solid Divider Plates:** Provide full separation between cable types, ideal for high-voltage or sensitive instrumentation cables
- Ventilated Divider Plates:** Allow airflow to reduce heat buildup while maintaining cable separation
- Adjustable or Modular Plates:** Can be repositioned along the tray to accommodate varying cable widths
- Splice Plates:** Connect two tray sections
