While the physical section length is fixed, the reserved length or capacity refers to the additional space left within the tray for future cable growth. Reserved Capacity and Fill Ratio To prevent overcrowding, overheating, and difficult maintenance, cable trays should not be filled beyond 40–50% of their cross-sectional area for power and control cables. This ensures proper ventilation and heat dissipation. For planning purposes, engineers typically reserve 25–40% of the tray width or cross-sectional area for future cable additions. This reserved space is sometimes called the "spare capacity" or "expansion margin." Example Calculation Determine total cable cross-sectional area: Sum the areas of all current cables. Apply fill ratio: For power cables, use 40%; for control cables, 50%. Add reserved capacity: Multiply the calculated tray area by 1.25 to 1.4 to account for future expansion. Select tray width and depth: Choose a tray size that accommodates the total area including the reserved margin. For instance, if a tray currently holds 20 power cables and 35 control cables, the recommended tray width should allow 25% extra space beyond the calculated fill to accommodate future cables. Practical Considerations Future-proofing: Reserved length ensures that additional cables can be installed without replacing the tray or adding parallel runs. Thermal management: Maintaining spare space improves airflow and reduces the risk of overheating. Compliance: NEC Article 392 and IEC 61537 standards recommend limiting fill and planning for expansion to maintain safety and inspection compliance...
