- Insulation safety:** Preventing damage, aging, or short circuits.
- Reliable connections:** Maintaining stable power supply to all connected devices.
- Compliance with safety standards:** Supporting protective devices like circuit breakers and residual current devices (RCDs) at each distribution level.

Role in Safety and Protection Cables in tertiary distribution boxes are closely linked to circuit protection devices. Each cable typically connects to a single-phase circuit breaker or RCD, ensuring that faults in one device do not affect others. This "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD" principle enhances safety and allows for independent control and protection of each electrical load.
