- Alternative Methods**
 - Router Settings:** You can manually release and renew the IP through your router's firmware or network settings.
 - Contacting ISP:** Requesting a new IP directly from your ISP ensures a change.
 - VPN Services:** Mask your public IP without changing the ISP-assigned address.
