However, compatibility is critical: ISPs often restrict which optical modules can be used, and using an unverified module may prevent the router from establishing an internet connection.

Key Considerations

- Module Type:** Ensure the SFP/SFP+ module matches the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and the network speed (1G, 10G, etc.).
- ISP Verification:** Always confirm with your ISP that the optical module is supported to avoid connectivity issues.
- Router Configuration:** After installing the module, the SFP/SFP+ interface must be configured as the WAN port in the router's settings.
- Distance and Media:** SFP ports allow flexibility for long-distance fiber connections, unlike standard RJ45 Ethernet ports, which are limited to shorter distances.
