

Can sockets be installed in the distribution box

These boxes centralize connections for multiple workstations and can be installed in raised floors, false ceilings, or on cable trays. They allow flexible addition or relocation of sockets without running new cables from the main patch panel. Connections are made using RJ45/stripped cords or copper feedthroughs, and the boxes are designed to maintain high performance by minimizing cable lengths.

Key Considerations Type of box: Electrical DBs are for power distribution; network boxes are for data connections. Do not mix high-voltage power sockets with low-voltage data sockets in the same enclosure. **Safety:** Electrical sockets must be connected to circuits with proper protection (MCBs/RCCBs). Network sockets require correct cabling and termination to maintain signal integrity. **Installation:** Both types of boxes can be mounted on walls, floors, or ceilings using screws, nails, or cable ties....
