- Number of Circuit Slots (Ways):** Each slot accommodates a circuit breaker or protective device. Residential AC panels commonly have 12, 18, or 24 slots, while DC distribution boxes may support 5, 8, or 15 devices depending on the model. Some slots are reserved for the main switch or surge protection devices, so the usable capacity is slightly lower than the total number of slots.

Practical Considerations

- Spare Capacity:** Experts recommend adding 20-30% spare slots to allow for future expansion, such as additional lighting, appliances, EV chargers, or solar systems.
- Load Matching:** The total capacity should match the expected electrical load of the building. Oversizing wastes space and money, while undersizing risks overloads and tripping.
- Safety Devices:** The distribution box includes circuit breakers, RCCBs, and surge protection devices to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electrical hazards.

A typical home distribution box might have 12 ways, with a main breaker rated at 100A. After accounting for the main switch and surge protection, it could safely accommodate 10 branch circuits for lighting, sockets, kitchen appliances, and HVAC systems. For DC systems, a Ferroamp Power Distribution 15 box can connect up to 15 devices to the DC grid, with a 63A main br...
