

Configure Cisco switch optical port interconnection



AI Overview

Cisco optical ports (SFP/SFP+) can be configured and monitored via CLI, ensuring proper transceiver type, fiber mode, and digital optical monitoring (DOM) for reliable network connectivity.

Basic Configuration Steps

Access the Switch CLI Connect via SSH or console to the Cisco switch.

Verify Port and SFP Status Use the following commands to check the optical port and transceiver:

- `show interface status` — confirms if the port is up and its type
- `show inventory` — lists installed SFPs with part number, vendor, and serial numbers
- `show interfaces transceiver detail` — displays DOM/DDM metrics such as Tx/Rx power, temperature, voltage, and bias currents
- `show idprom interface` — reads EEPROM/vendor information from the SFP

Enable the Port if Err-Disabled If the port is disabled due to an unsupported transceiver:

```
CodeCopyconf tno errdisable detect cause gbic-invalid
```

This allows the switch to accept compatible third-party SFPs.

Fiber Type Considerations

Single-mode vs Multimode: Ensure the SFP matches the fiber type. Single-mode SFPs must connect to single-mode fiber, and multimode SFPs to multimode fiber.

Distance and Compatibility: Verify the SFP supports the required distance and speed. Cisco switches are generally "blind" to the fiber type as long as the transceiver and cable are compatible.

Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM)

DOM provides real-time monitoring of optical parameters: transmit power, receive power, temperature, voltage, and laser bias current.

On Cisco Meraki switches (MS120, MS125, MS210, etc.), DOM is automatically enabled on firmware MS 17+ and can be viewed in the dashboard under **Switching > Monitor > Switches > Ports**.

Thresholds indicate normal, high, or low readings, helping detect issues like broken fibers or misaligned connectors.

Troubleshooting Tips

No Light / Low Rx Power: Check fiber cleanliness, cable integrity, and remote transmitter status.
