The internal layout is critical for safety and maintenance, providing sufficient space for wiring, heat dissipation, and future expansion. Proper separation of power and lighting circuits is recommended to prevent interference.

Installation Guidelines

Location: Close to the main power supply, in a ventilated, dry area away from harmful gases, liquids, heat sources, or vibration zones.

Accessibility: Allow enough space for two people to work simultaneously; avoid stacking materials or obstructing access.

Construction: Boxes should be made of iron plate (>1.5mm) or high-quality insulating material, with metal mounting plates electrically bonded to the enclosure.

Wiring: Use insulated wires with secure connections; separate protective neutral and working neutral lines; no exposed live parts.
