Ensure the corner installation complies with relevant standards like NEC Article 392 or BS EN 61537 for safety and performance. Secure the tray to supports and verify that the corner does not compromise the tray's load-bearing capacity. Safety and Maintenance Only trained personnel should perform installation.
