Cable Laying Once the trench or conduit is ready, fiber optic cables are deployed while adhering to tension and bending radius guidelines to prevent damage. Proper handling ensures the integrity of the fiber and reduces signal loss.

Splicing and Termination After laying the cables, splicing connects individual fiber strands using fusion or mechanical splicing techniques. Termination involves installing connectors (e.g., SC, LC, FC) and connecting the fiber to network equipment like Optical Line Terminals (OLTs) or Opt...
