

Copper wire connection to the distribution box

Preparing the Distribution Box Before connecting any wires, ensure the power supply is completely turned off and verify with a tester that no electricity is present. Grounding Connection: Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire for grounding. Connect it to the PE (Protective Earth) bar or grounding terminal inside the box. Strip the wire, insert it into the terminal, and tighten the screw securely. If electrical components inside the box require grounding, connect them to the PE bar as well.

Wire Management and Safety Arrange wires neatly inside the box, using cable ties to prevent tangling and to maintain clearance for heat dissipation. Ensure all connections are firm and clearly marked for future inspection and maintenance. Use wires with a cross-sectional area suitable for the load, following local electrical codes. After wiring, perform insulation resistance tests and check circuit continuity to confirm proper installation.
