1. VLAN and Trunk SettingsAssign VLAN IDs for different network segments and configure trunk ports for inter-switch communication. Set native VLANs and allowed VLANs on trunk ports to prevent VLAN hopping and ensure proper traffic segregation .Example (Aruba): `vlan trunk native 100` and `vlan trunk allowed 100`
2. DHCP and IP ManagementEnable DHCP snooping to prevent rogue DHCP servers. Configure IP addresses for management interfaces, default gateways, and subnet masks .Example: `ip dhcp snooping` and `seq match vendor-oui` for device-specific DHCP filtering
3. Security FeaturesEnable ARP inspection to prevent ARP spoofing. Configure port security and excessive traffic thresholds (broadcasts, flaps, jabbers, CRC errors) to protect the network
4. IGMP and MulticastEnable IGMP snooping to optimize multicast traffic and reduce unnecessary flooding
5. Interface and Port SettingsConfigure access and trunk ports with appropriate reauthentication periods. Set LLDP groups for device discovery and AP association in wireless deployments
6. Redundancy and High AvailabilityUse HSRP or VRRP for virtual gateway redundancy. Ensure dual-core or aggregation switches are configured for load sharing and failover
7. Module and Backplane ConsiderationsChoose interface modules (RJ-45, SFP, 10Gbps) based on network requirements. Ensure backplane bandwidth supports inter-port communication without bottlenecks
