

# Core Switch Configuration Time Synchronization



## AI Overview

Core switches can be configured as NTP servers to provide accurate time to network devices and servers, ensuring consistent time across the network. Configuring a Core Switch as an NTP Server

To configure a Cisco core switch (e.g., 4500 series) as an NTP server:

- Set the system clock (optional but recommended to reduce initial drift):`CodeCopyclock set HH:MM:SS MONTH DAY YEAR`
- Configure the NTP server using a reliable time source, such as GPS or an upstream NTP server:`CodeCopyntp server`
- Enable NTP server functionality on the core switch:`CodeCopyntp master`

The stratum level defines the hierarchy; lower numbers indicate higher accuracy. Verify NTP status:`CodeCopyshow ntp associationsshow ntp status`

The \* symbol next to an IP indicates the primary synchronization source.

Synchronizing Other Switches or Devices

Other switches or servers can synchronize with the core switch by configuring the core switch's IP as their NTP server:

- Cisco access switches:`CodeCopyntp server`
- Windows servers:`CodeCopyw32tm /config /manualpeerlist:"IP_of_Core_Switch" /syncfromflags:manual /reliable:yes /updatew32tm /resync`

For redundancy, multiple NTP servers can be listed so the client automatically switches if one server fails.

Best Practices

- Redundancy: Configure at least two core switches as NTP sources to prevent single points of failure.
- Hierarchical NTP: Core switches sync to a primary NTP source (GPS or external NTP), and access switches sync to the core switches to reduce load and improve reliability.
- Time zone configuration: Optional for display purposes; NTP internally uses UTC.
- Verification: Regularly check `show ntp associations` and `show ntp status` to ensure synchronization is maintained.
- Drift management: If client clocks drift too far from the master, initial manual clock adjustment may be necessary to prevent NTP errors.
