

Correct installation of circuit breakers in distribution boxes

- Branch Circuit Breakers:** Protect individual circuits such as lighting, sockets, motors, or appliances. Single-pole (1P) breakers are common for lighting and general loads, while 2P breakers are used for sockets, water heaters, or high-power circuits.
- RCD/RCBO:** Optional devices for residual current protection, isolating only the affected circuit in case of leakage.

Installation Sequence

- Incoming Power:** Connect line (L) and neutral (N) from the utility or generator to the main breaker input.
- Main Breaker:** Install at the top-left or designated position; use 2P for full isolation.
- Branch Breakers:** Arrange from left to right, with high-power circuits closer to the main breaker and low-power circuits further away to manage heat and load distribution.
- Neutral and Ground Connections:** Terminate all neutral wires on the neutral bar and all grounding wires on the PE bar, keeping them separate to prevent fault currents.
- Load Balancing:** For three-phase systems, distribute loads evenly across L1, L2, and L3.
