

Dimensions of steel cable trays for base stations

Shallow trays are suitable for lightweight cables, while deeper trays support multiple layers of large-diameter cables and provide better containment during seismic events or accidental impacts.

LengthsStandard tray sections are manufactured in predetermined lengths to facilitate handling and installation:

- Typical lengths: 2 m, 3 m, 6 m (or 78 in, 120 in, 288 in)

Longer spans may require intermediate supports or splice plates to maintain structural integrity.

Material ThicknessMaterial thickness varies depending on the duty class and load requirements:

- Light-duty trays: thinner steel, suitable for small cables
- Medium-duty trays: moderate thickness for general power and control cables
- Heavy-duty trays: thicker steel for large power cables or high-density installations

Ladder trays prioritize side rail height and material thickness for load capacity, while perforated trays provide ventilation and uniform cable support.
