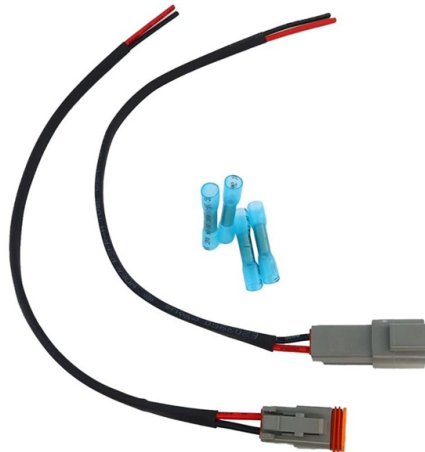


Direction of power cord from the house s electrical distribution box



AI Overview

The power cord from a house's electrical distribution box carries electricity from the utility supply into the main isolator, then through protective devices, and finally distributes it to subcircuits via MCBs and neutral/earth connections.

Main Power Entry The main power cord enters the house from the utility pole or service line and is first connected to the energy meter to measure consumption. From the meter, the phase (live) and neutral wires are routed to the main isolator switch, which serves as the primary on/off control for the house's electrical system. The main isolator allows safe disconnection of power for maintenance or emergencies.

Routing Inside the Distribution Box After the main isolator, the phase wire is typically connected to the RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) or RCD (Residual-Current Device), which protects against current leakage and electric shock. The neutral wire is connected to the neutral bus bar inside the distribution board. From the RCCB, the phase wire is distributed in parallel to the MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers), each protecting individual circuits such as lighting, outlets, or appliances. The neutral bus bar is shared across all circuits, completing the return path for current.

Grounding The earth wire is connected to the ground bus bar in the distribution box, providing a safe path for fault currents and protecting against electric shock. All metallic parts of appliances and outlets are connected to this grounding system.

Direction and Layout

Incoming power: Utility → Energy meter → Main isolator

Protection devices: Main isolator → RCCB → MCBs

Distribution: MCBs → Individual circuits (lights, outlets, appliances)

Neutral return: All circuits → Neutral bus bar → Main neutral line

Earth connection: All metallic parts → Ground bus bar → Earth rod or plate
