Insulation-piercing or displacement connectors: Allow connection without stripping the wire, useful in certain industrial applications. Mechanical set-screw connectors: Secure the wire to a terminal or grounding bar. Proper Connection in a Distribution Box Locate the grounding bar (PE bar): Open the distribution box and identify the grounding terminal marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. Prepare the wire: Strip the insulation of the copper core ground wire to the required length. Attach the connector: Use the appropriate connector type to join the ground wire to the PE bar or metal enclosure. Ensure the connection is tight and secure to maintain low resistance. Ground electrical components: Any internal components requiring grounding should also be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. Mark and inspect: Clearly label the grounding connections for maintenance and verify that no looseness exists. Safety Considerations Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting code requirements for visibility and conductivity. Ensure all connections comply with NEC Section 250.8 and local electrical codes. Verify continuity of the grounding path to prevent shock hazards and ensure proper...
