Planning and Route Design Before installation, plan the cable tray route carefully, considering clearance, load capacity, and separation from other utilities or structures. Mark the route and identify support points, bends, and expansion joints in advance to minimize on-site adjustments and ensure compliance with local electrical codes.

Material Selection For outdoor use, select corrosion-resistant materials such as galvanized steel, stainless steel (AISI 316L), or aluminum alloys. These materials resist atmospheric corrosion, UV exposure, and moisture, ensuring long-term durability. Ensure that all components, including connectors, elbows, and covers, are compatible and designed for outdoor conditions.

Support and Mounting Install supports at regular intervals, typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load. For elbows and bends, place supports according to NEMA VE 2 guidelines, avoiding placing connectors at the center of spans. Use brackets, struts, or threaded rods suitable for outdoor conditions, and ensure that trays are level and aligned. Expansion joints should be installed at building expansion points and long runs (every 30 meters or as specified) to accommodate thermal expansion.

Cable Laying and Securing Lay cables neatly within the tray, separating by voltage and function. Use UV-resistant cable ties or straps at intervals of 1.8 meters for horizontal runs and 0.9 meters for vertical runs to prevent movement. Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables and avoid overfilling the tray to prevent overheating or mechanical stress.

Grounding and Bonding Ensure all metal trays are properly grounded. Install bonding jumpers at expansion joints and ground trays at least every 15 meters and at both ends. Conduit drop-outs should also be bonded to the tray using compression lugs o...
