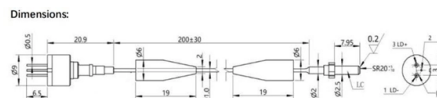

Metallic Interconnection: All metal panels, frames, and DIN rails should be interconnected to provide a common ground reference.

Plastic Cabinets: If used, grounding must be provided via the DIN rail, but metal cabinets are preferred for EMC protection.

EMC Components: EMI filters and clamps should be mounted directly on metallic surfaces without insulating coatings to divert unwanted currents away from sensitive electronics.
