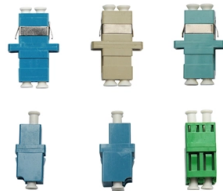

Mounting and Accessibility: Wall mounting is common for indoor boxes, but ensure the mounting substrate can support the weight of the enlarged box and all components. Leave sufficient clearance for opening doors and accessing breakers.

Future-Proofing: Consider modular designs with DIN rails and extra cable entry points. This allows easy addition of smart home modules, surge protection, or additional circuits without major reconstruction.
