

Enlarging the wire hole in the distribution box

- Wire Protection** After enlarging the hole, install a grommet or bushing to protect wires from sharp edges. This is especially important for Romex or multi-conductor cables to prevent insulation damage and reduce the risk of short circuits.
- Sizing and Code Considerations** Ensure the hole is large enough for all wires but not excessively oversized. A 3/4 inch hole may suffice for two 12 AWG Romex cables, but check local electrical codes for maximum fill limits. If the hole passes through a fire-rated wall, consider using a firestop to maintain the wall's fire-resistance rating. In some cases, if access is limited, firestopping may be optional, but it is recommended whenever possible.
- Avoid enlarging holes in a way that compromises the IP/NEMA rating of outdoor or industrial boxes.**
- Alternative Approach** If enlarging the existing hole is difficult or risky, drilling a new hole nearby...
