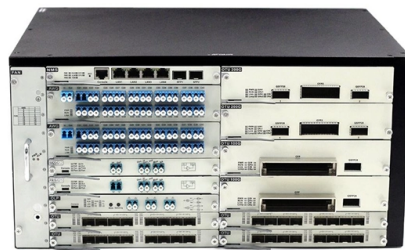


Fiber Optic Cable Distribution Reel Splicing Requirements Standards

Fiber optic splicing from distribution reels must follow strict standards for equipment, procedures, loss limits, labeling, and documentation to ensure network performance and compliance. Splicing fiber optic cables requires fusion or mechanical splicing using approved tools and techniques. Key equipment includes: Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) for measuring splice loss and span analysis. Optical Power Meter and Laser Light Source to verify continuity and power loss at 1310nm and 1550nm wavelengths. Launch reels (1 km) for pigtail testing to accurately measure connector and splice losses on short spans. Proper index of refraction must be used according to fiber type during testing (UTOPIA Fiber standards). Loss and Quality Standards Splice loss limits are defined by the provider or project specifications, typically ≤ 0.1 dB for single-mode fibers. Connector loss and back reflection must be measured and documented. OTDR traces should be taken from both directions, and the average loss calculated to ensure accuracy. Encircled flux (EF) conditioning is recommended for consistent OTDR measurements. Fiber Storage and Slack Management Maintain proper fiber slack in trays and routing to prevent microbends or stress. Avoid prohibited practices such as sharp bends, over-tight loops, or improper tray placement. Use gel-sealed or appropriate closures for outdoor splices to protect against environmental factors. Labeling and Documentation Cable and splice labeling must be clear, including backbone and distribution identifiers. As-built documentation should reflect actual field conditions, including fiber counts, terminal sizes, and route changes. Photos with timestamp, GPS coordinates, and site identifiers are required for verification. Splice counts and unit totals must be clearly tallied and highlighted in the as-built records.
