3. Splicing Procedure Insert fibers into the splicer V-grooves, ensuring the cleaved ends are properly aligned and not touching any surfaces. Close clamps gently and initiate the fusion process. After splicing, place the splice in a protective sleeve and heat-shrink it using the splicer's heater chamber.
4. Testing and Quality Assurance Students should test each splice using an OTDR or other optical testing equipment to measure loss and reflectance. Emphasize the importance of re-cleaning fiber ends if splicing for extended periods to maintain low-loss performance.
5. Hands-On Practice Begin with single-fiber splices before progressing to ribbon fibers. Practice placing splices i...
