Power Requirements for Fiber Optic Cables Fiber optic cables themselves do not carry electrical power, as they transmit data via light. - Power Supply Units (PSUs):** Centralized PSUs in IDF rooms feed power through hybrid cables to endpoints, reducing the need for local AC outlets.

Fiber Optic Modules Transceiver modules are essential for converting electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa. Common types include SFP, SFP+, SFP28, and QSFP. Considerations include:

- Data Rate and Compatibility:** Modules must match the host device's PHY and firmware. SFP supports 1G, SFP+ 10G, SFP28 25G, and QSFP modules can support 40G or 100G links.
- Optical Type:** Singlemode or multimode fiber compatibility is critical. For example, Cisco 100GBASE-SR4 QSFP modules support OM3/OM4 multimode fiber with MPO connectors for short-range links.
- Power and Diagnostics:** Modern modules include Digital Diagnostic Monitoring (DDM/DOM) to report temperature, supply voltage, and optical power, ensuring safe operation and preventing overloading.
