The final connection to the end-user is typically made via a fiber optic termination box or optical network unit (ONU), which converts the optical signal into a form usable by household devices. Termination boxes / ONUs: Interface with end-user devices, provide the actual broadband connection. Broadband access: While splice boxes are essential for routing and splitting fiber signals, they cannot directly provide broadband to a home or office; they are part of the infrastructure that enables the connection. In practice, a splice box is a critical component in the network path, ensuring reliable data transmission, but the actual broadband connection to a subscriber requires a termination point or ONU.
