Fiber Cable Installation Installation methods depend on the project design and site conditions:

- Aerial Installation:** Cables are strung between utility poles using pulleys and tensioners, secured with clamps and spacers. This method is faster and less disruptive, suitable for suburban or rural areas.
- Underground Installation:** Cables are pulled through conduits or ducts. Techniques include traditional trenching, microtrenching (narrow, shallow trenches), plowing, or directional drilling. Microtrenching is cost-effective and minimizes urban disruption.
- Blowing or Jetting:** Fiber can be installed through conduits using compressed air for long-distance runs, reducing stress on the cable.
