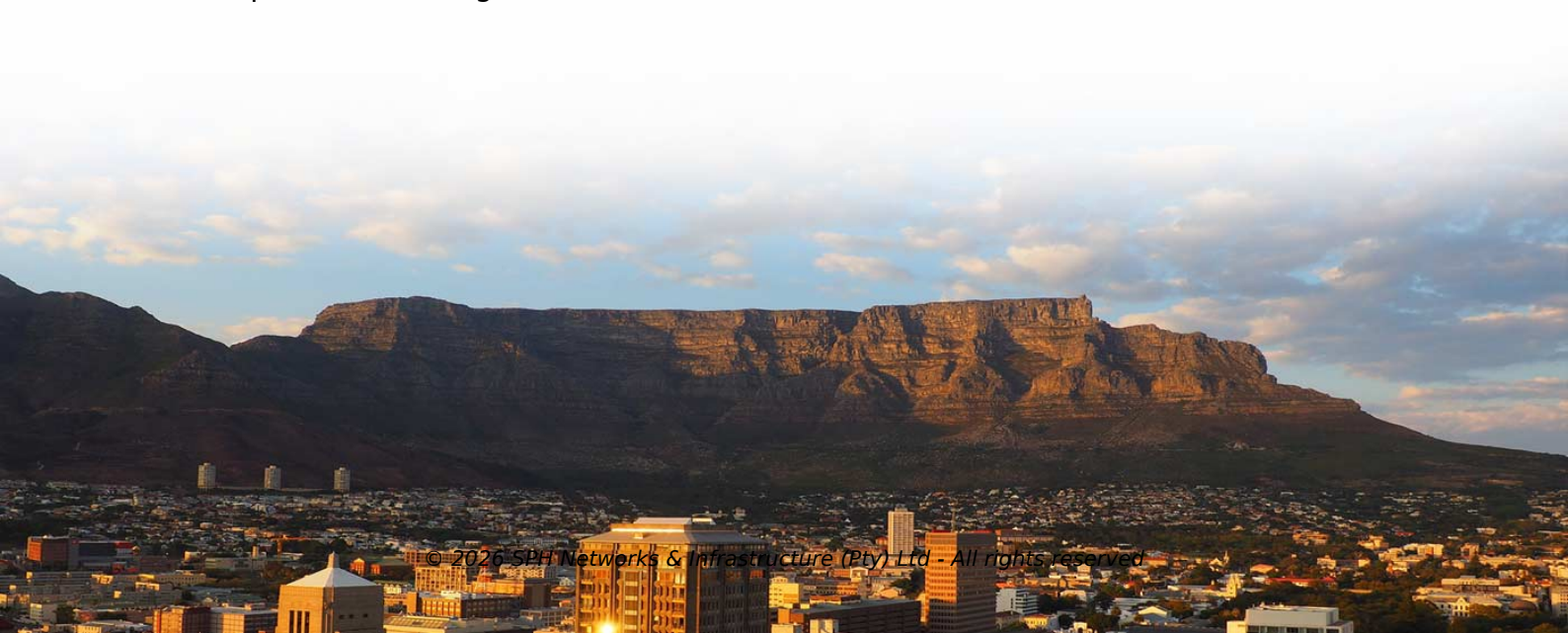


Fiber optic cable pre-reel marking



Overview

Approve marking content before cable production begins. Use one unique drum number for each physical reel. Define cable sheath text, sequential meter marks, drum labels and export shipping marks before production to prevent identification errors, documentation disputes and installation confusion. Direct Answer: Before production, buyers should approve the exact sheath-printing text, meter-marking. And finally, the cable has distance marked - "00030 FEET" - on this cable it's updated every 2 feet. Here is an excellent example of. Cable jackets are typically made of medium-density polyethylene and high-density polyethylene as well as polyurethane (PU) and polyamide (PA), all of which present challenges for ink adherence.
