- Inspect and Clean:** Ensure fiber terminations and switch ports are clean to prevent signal loss.
- Align and Insert:** Carefully insert the fiber connectors into the corresponding SFP ports, ensuring proper alignment for send and receive channels.
- Duplex Cabling:** Use two strands of fiber for duplex communication, connecting the transmit port of one switch to the receive port of the other and vice versa.
- Topology Considerations:** Common topologies include star (central switch) and cascade (daisy-chained switches). Avoid excessive cascading to prevent loops and congestion; typically, no more than four layers are recommended.
- Testing:** Verify connection integrity using optical power meters or visual fault locators to ensure proper signal transmission.
