- Hardware Failures:** Faulty routers, ONTs, or transceivers may prevent proper operation.
- Power Problems:** Unstable or disconnected power sources can cause lights to go off or blink.
- Service Outages:** ISP maintenance or local outages can trigger LOS or red lights.
- Configuration Errors:** IP conflicts, firmware bugs, or incorrect routing may affect connectivity.
