Cutting and Drilling: Fiberglass can be cut and drilled like hardwood. Use carbide-tipped saw blades or standard twist drills, applying moderate pressure to avoid chipping or resin softening. Seal any cut or drilled surfaces with compatible resin to maintain structural integrity.

Installation Sequence: Conduct on-site inspections and pre-measure bends, ramps, and T-junctions. Install supports first, ensuring alignment and stability. Place tray sections, maintaining proper spacing and alignment. Splices should ideally be located at quarter-span points. Secure trays with clamps, brackets, and cable tie mounts to prevent movement.

Safety Precautions: Wear masks, long sleeves, and gloves when cutting or drilling to prevent skin irritation from fiberglass dust. Handle trays careful...
