- 4. Install Supports and Mounting**Use appropriate brackets, clamps, or struts for wall, ceiling, or floor mounting. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters, depending on tray type and load. Ensure supports are level and secure to prevent sagging. For long runs, consider cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth cable installation.
- 5. Assemble and Align Trays**Connect tray sections using compatible fittings and connectors. Align trays straight and level, taking care not to damage the galvanized coating. Avoid scratches or cuts, as exposed steel can corrode even with galvanization. For hot-dip galvanized trays, minor scratches form a protective zinc patina over time.
- 6. Install Cables**Lay cables carefully, maintaining proper separation and bend radius. Avoid overfilling the tray. Use cable ties or clamps to secure cables without damaging insulation. Ensure compliance with electrical codes for spacing a...
