Passive Device: The splitter does not require any power supply, making it reliable and low-maintenance.

Signal Division: It divides the incoming optical signal into multiple outputs according to a split ratio, such as 1:2, 1:4, 1:8, 1:16, 1:32, or even 1:64. For example, a 1:32 splitter can serve 32 users from a single fiber.

Bandwidth Sharing: The total bandwidth of the fiber is shared among all connected users. Each user receives sufficient signal power as long as the optical network terminal (ONT) can operate correctly.

Placement: Splitters can be centralized (located at a central office or cabinet) or distributed (placed closer to end users in pedestals or closures), depending on network design.

Advantages

Cost Efficiency: Reduces the number of fibers needed and eliminates the need for powered equipment in the distribution network.

Scalability: Supports a large number of users from a single fiber, making it ideal for dense residential or business areas.

Reliability: Passive operation ensures minimal maintenance and high network uptime.

Role in GPON Networks In a GPON setup, the OLT sends downstream data to all connected ONTs. The optical splitter divides this signal so multiple ONTs can receive it simultaneously. Upstream data from ONTs is coordinated using time-division multiple access (TDMA) to prevent collisions. This architecture allows gigabit speeds to be s...
