4. Maintain Neutral-Ground Separation In a sub-panel, the neutral bus must not be bonded to the panel enclosure or the grounding bar. The neutral is only bonded at the main service panel. This prevents neutral current from flowing on metal parts of the sub-panel, which could create a shock hazard.
5. Verify Grounding Continuity Ensure that the ground connections are continuous and secure. For metal enclosures, you may use grounding screws or clips to bond the box to the grounding bar. The total ground resistance should be low enough to allow proper operation of overcurrent protection devices.
6. Additional Precautions Clearly mark all grounding connections for inspection and maintenance. Avoid loose connections, as they can compromise safety. Ensure the grounding system...
