GB50303-2002 (China) specifies that stainless steel enclosures should have a bottom surface 1.3–1.5 meters above the ground, considering operator ergonomics. Adequate clearance around the box is required for safe access, ventilation, and future maintenance, with at least enough space for two people to work simultaneously. Additional Considerations Outdoor boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet (≈ 0.9 meters) above the ground to protect against water and dirt. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2–4 inches to prevent moisture damage. Ensure the installation location is dry, well-ventilated, and free from corrosive or hazardous environments. Compliance with IP or NEMA ratings is essential for protection against dust and water ingress, especially in industrial or outdoor settings. Regular maintenance and inspections are recommended to ensure long-term reliability and safety.
