Separation in Sub-Boards: In sub-distribution boards, neutral and ground bars are usually kept separate to prevent circulating currents. Proper installation requires correct wire gauge, secure connections, and insulation to prevent overheating, short circuits, or fire hazards. Each circuit should also have its own protective device, such as a miniature circuit breaker (MCB) or residual current device (RCD), to enhance safety.

Best Practices

- Always turn off the main power before working inside the distribution box.
- Ensure neat cable management and proper labeling of neutral and ground wires for easy maintenance.
- Use UL/CE-certified components and follow local electrical codes for compliance and safety.
- Schedule regular inspections to check for loose connections or corrosion on neutral and grou...
