

How far should the distribution box be from the ground

- Safety and environment:** Install in dry, well-ventilated areas, avoiding corrosive gases, liquids, or other harmful media.
- Space for maintenance:** Reserve sufficient operating space around the box, ideally enough for two people to work simultaneously, and maintain clear passageways for emergency access.
- Grounding:** Proper grounding is essential. Attach a ground wire from the box to the mounting plate and then to the central grounding point, ensuring total ground resistance is below 0.1 Ohm.
- Consistency:** Maintain uniform installation height for similar boxes within the same facility to facilitate systematic management and aesthetic uniformity.
