- Splice Plates:** Ideally, only one splice plate should be placed between supports to maintain structural integrity.
- Corners and Bends:** Install a support on each side of bends or T-junctions to prevent stress on cables.
- Vertical Runs:** Supports should be spaced preferably less than 2 meters to maintain stability.
- Cable Securing:** Cables should be secured at the start, end, and turns, and every 3 to 5 meters along straight horizontal sections.

With a support span of 20" and a total working load of 80 lbs/ft, a NEMA Class 20B tray rated at 75 lbs/ft will not be adequate. A NEMA Class 20C tray, rated at 100 lbs/ft, will be required.
