The number of fibers from a BBU depends on how many services or ONTs it supports. Practical Example A residential BBU serving a single ONT typically uses one fiber to the ODF. A multi-service BBU in a central office or aggregation point may use multiple fibers, each connecting to different ODF ports or splitters to serve multiple ONTs or RRUs. In FTTH (Fiber to the Antenna) setups, hybrid cables may carry both power and multiple fibers from the BBU to remote units, reducing the total number of separate cables while still providing multiple fiber connections.
