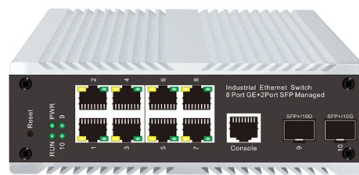

In summary, while a single-fiber cable exists for simple connections, most practical optical cables contain 12, 24, 48, 72, or 144 fibers, with specialized high-capacity cables reaching thousands of fibers for large-scale telecommunications and data center applications .
