

# How to connect an LC fiber optic cold splice

- 3. Insert the Fiber into the LC Mechanical Splice** Open the mechanical splice connector and align the fiber with the zirconia ferrule inside the connector. Carefully insert the fiber until it stops, ensuring proper alignment with the internal metal contact faces. For connectors with a crimp or clamp mechanism, secure the fiber using the appropriate hand tool to prevent movement.
- 4. Inspect and Polish (if required)** Some mechanical LC connectors may require light polishing of the fiber tip using fiber optic polishing film to maximize contact area. Inspect the connector tip under a microscope to confirm there are no scratches or defects.
- 5. Test the Connection** Use a fiber optic power meter or OTDR to measure insertion loss and verify signal quality. Ensure the loss is within acceptable limits for your network specifications.
- 6. Secure the Fiber** Place the connected LC fiber in a patch panel or rack.
