4. Handle with Care Avoid bending the fiber beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent breakage or signal attenuation. Wear safety gloves and glasses to protect against tiny glass shards . Work in a clean, dust-free environment to prevent contamination of the fiber ends.
5. Test the Connection After connecting, use an optical power meter or network tester to verify signal strength and ensure minimal loss. Proper testing confirms that the thin fiber is transmitting data efficiently .
